

DISPOSITION CODES TO BE USED IN MUNICIPAL COURTS

OLD CODE	DESCRIPTION	NEW CODE
NP	Dismissed when the city attorney or prosecuting officer declares before trial his or her intent not to prosecute the charge(s).	1A
DM	Dismissed by the judge when time has expired to prosecute the charge(s).	1B
--	Dismissed by the judge for some reason other than time has expired.	1C
GP	Guilty when the defendant pleads guilty or no contest before trial and is given any sentence other than a deferred sentence.	1D
--	Guilty when the defendant enters a plea before trial and is given a deferred sentence but it is not yet known whether the defendant has complied with the conditions of deferment.	1G
CI	Dismissed when the defendant makes a plea before trial and is given a deferred sentence and successfully complies with the conditions of deferment.	1H
CC	Guilty when the defendant makes a plea before trial and is given a deferred sentence but fails to comply with the conditions of deferment.	1J
TF	Dismissed when the case is transferred to District Court for Competency Hearing.	1K
--	Dismissed when the defendant produces a valid driver's license or proof of financial responsibility valid at the time of issuance of the citation per the applicable municipal ordinance	1M
DL	Dismissed for failure to prosecute when the officer fails to appear at trial.	1N
--	Dismissed when the charges from a related/companion case are consolidated (i.e., the charges are entered) into another criminal case (i.e., the primary case). Use this code at the time of consolidation and only on the charge(s) previously entered in the related/companion case.	IP
NA	Dismissed when the defendant is found not guilty of the charge(s) by a judge during or after a bench trial .	3A
DT	Dismissed when the judge or city attorney or prosecuting officer dismisses the charge against the defendant during or after a bench trial .	3B
--	Dismissed when the city attorney dismisses the charge(s) or fails to re-try after a mistrial in a bench trial.	3C
GT	Guilty when the defendant makes a guilty or no contest plea and is given any sentence other than a deferred sentence during a bench trial .	3D
--	Dismissed when the defendant is convicted of a charge or pleads to a charge during a bench trial , is given a deferred sentence, but it is not yet known whether the defendant has complied with the conditions of deferment.	3G
CI	Dismissed when the defendant is convicted of a charge or pleads guilty to a charge during a bench trial , is given a deferred sentence and successfully meets the conditions of the deferment.	3H
CC	Guilty when the defendant is convicted of a charge in a bench trial or pleads guilty to a charge during a bench trial , is given a deferred sentence but fails to comply with the conditions of deferment.	3I
NC	Guilty when the defendant is found guilty by a judge during or after a bench trial and is given any sentence other than a deferred sentence.	3J
--	Dismissed by the judge when a witness failed to appear.	3L
